This letter is to inform you that the unannounced inspection for Phytamin® Fish (cof-1816), Phytamin® Fish Concentrate (cof-1817), Phytamin® All-Purpose (cof-1818), Phytamin® Fish Plus (cof-1819), NitroFlow™ Fish Plus (cof-2080), NitroFlow™ Fish Concentrate (cof-2081), NitroFlow™ All-Purpose (cof-2083), Phytamin® Clear (cof-2123), and Phytamin® Fish Gold (cof-2188) is complete. The inspection report indicated that the manufacturing processes were verified and records were audited. OMRI has reviewed the unannounced inspection results and has determined that the products are approved for use in NOP organic production. The products will continue to be listed on the *OMRI Products List* in its current category and use class. A copy of the unannounced inspection report is enclosed.

OMRI has identified these products as high nitrogen liquid fertilizers and they are therefore subject to the NOP Policy which requires both an announced and an unannounced inspection annually. These inspections are complete for this year. Phytamin® Fish will still receive another announced as well as an unannounced inspection in the next 12 months.

OMRI will send California Organic Fertilizers a renewal packet ten weeks prior to your annual product renewal date. To maintain your listing, you must submit an annual renewal fee along with all other documentation requested in the renewal packet one month prior to the listing expiration date.
